

# Online Master Gardener Class



**Online Course Information:** This online course is a self-paced, self-study format with 17 modules on Soils, Fertilizers, Plant Growth & Development, Vegetables, Ornamental plants, Trees and Shrubs, Landscape Design, Pruning, Turfgrass, Irrigation, Small Fruit, Tree Fruit, Composting, and Integrated Pest Management. Each module contains a presentation video, class notes, study guides and handouts (if applicable).

The course includes hands-on activities to help users familiarize themselves with the topics discussed in the presentations, as well as quizzes that must be completed after each module has been studied.

A Montana Master Gardener certification will be issued to the user upon completion of this course with a passing final grade and when 20 volunteer service hours have been achieved. Users have one year from course completion to obtain the required volunteer hours.

**Cost:** \$100 per student. Students will need to make 3 separate payments to the following:
